**Town of Greenville FIRST PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE FFY 2018 CDBG Program year**  
 The Town of Greenville is considering applying to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for one or more Small Cities Community Development Block Grants (CDBG) for the 2018 CDBG program year. Each grant is expected to not exceed \$600,000. CDBG funds may be used for one of the following purposes: 1. To benefit low and moderate income persons; 2. To aid in the prevention or elimination of slums or blight; or 3. To meet other community development needs of recent origin having a particular urgency because existing conditions pose a serious and immediate threat to the health or welfare of the community and where other financial resources are not available to meet such needs. The categories of activities for which these funds may be used are in the areas of housing, neighborhood revitalization, commercial revitalization, or economic development and include such improvement activities as acquisition of real property, loans to private-for-profit business, purchase of machinery and equipment, construction of infrastructure, planning/design, rehabilitation of houses and commercial buildings, and energy conservation.  
 In developing an application for submission to DEO, the Town of Greenville must plan to minimize displacement of persons as a result of planned CDBG activities. In addition, the Town is required to develop a plan to assist displaced persons. A public hearing to receive citizen views concerning the community's economic and community development needs will be held on **Thursday, May 23, 2019 at 6:00 p.m.** or as soon thereafter as may be heard, at the Town of Greenville Town Hall located at **154 SW Old Mission Avenue, Greenville, Florida 32331**. Additional information regarding the range of activities that may be undertaken with funding from the CDBG grant program will be provided at the public hearing.
