These notices shall satisfy two separate but related procedural requirements for activities to be undertaken by the Town of Greenville.
REQUEST FOR RELEASE OF FUNDS
On or about June 5, 2019, the Town of Greenville, Florida will submit a request to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO) for the release of Community Development Block Grant funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development (HCD) Act of 1974, as amended, to undertake a project to demolish the Town's existing senior center building and to construct a new senior/youth center community building in its place. The location of the existing senior center (the site of the new community center after the existing building is demolished) is next to Greenville's Town Hall on North 1st Street between Broad Street and Church Street. The existing community center is in a deteriorated condition and is not suitable for accommodating both seniors and youth at the same time - which the new center is designed to do. This CDBG project will also include a town-wide water meter replacement project. All active water meters within the town limits will be replaced (approximately 343 meters). Nearly all of the existing water meters are well over 20 year of age and no longer accurately measure water use, and therefore need to be replaced.

In addition, pending available funds, the town may also create a water feature/splash pad or pool adjacent to the planned community center. Also, if funds are available the town may rehabilitate the headworks at its wastewater treatment plant (WWTP) and demolish WWTP components (abandoned concrete tanks/structures) that are no longer in service. The Town's WWTP is located in unincorporated Madison County on SE Greenville Hill's Road, approximately 1/3 mile east of US Highway 221.
FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT
The Town of Greenville has determined that the project will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required. Additional project information is contained in the Environmental Review Record (ERR) on file at City Hall at located at 154 SW Old Mission Avenue, P. O. Box 235, Greenville, Florida 32331 and may be examined or copied weekdays 8:30 A.M to 4:30 P.M.

PUBLIC COMMENTS
Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the office of the Town Clerk, Ms. Kimberly Reams. All comments must be received by June 3, 2019. Comments will be considered prior to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity requesting a release of funds. Comments should specify which notice they are addressing.

RELEASE OF FUNDS
The Town of Greenville certifies to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity and HUD that Britni Brown in her capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The State's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows City of Port St. Joe to use the CDBG funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS
DEO will accept objections to its release of funds and the City of Port St. Joe certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the City of Port St. Joe; (b) the City of Port St. Joe has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient has committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the State; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures at 24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76 and shall be addressed to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity, CDBG Program, MSC-400, 107 East Madison Street, Tallahassee, FL 32399-6508. Potential objectors should contact the City of Port St. Joe to verify the actual last day of the objection period. Written comments may be mailed to Britni Brown, Mayor, C/O Kimberly Reams, Town Clerk, at P.O. Box 235 Greenville, FL 32331, or delivered to the Greenville Town Hall which is located at 154 SW Old Mission Avenue, FL 32331, on or before June 3, 2019.
